Matter highlights include:

- The National Music Publishers' Association and Nashville Songwriters Association International in the successful ruling by the Copyright Royalty Board to increase 2018-2022 royalty rates by nearly 44% to songwriters and music publishers from music streaming companies such as Google, Apple, Amazon, Spotify, and Pandora.
- META against Meta Platforms, Inc. (formerly Facebook) in litigation involving trademark infringement and unfair competition causes of action.
- Wilmington Savings Fund Society, FSB (WSFS), as indenture trustee and notes collateral agent of various bond indentures issued by Inco. - An artist's foundation in helping to expose the largest art fraud in American history; and a related but separate representation of the purchaser of multimillion-dollar fake "Mark Rothko" painting from the gallery at the center of the fraud (*Martin Hilti Family Trust v. Knoedler Gallery LLC*).
- Richemont, a Swiss luxury goods brand that produces and sells jewelry, watches, leather goods, clothing, and accessories, in connection with various global litigation matters.
